

Call For Art 2024

Artworks can be in any media (paintings, sculptures, drawings, installations, films, animations, sound works, photographs, craft and anything else). You can apply for a grant to help with materials costs, however you do not need a grant to take part.

Artworks can be on any topic. You are welcome to respond to this year's Scottish Mental Health Art Festival theme '**In/Visible**', however this is not a requirement.
